

## BELLI WANTS HEARING IN CHICAGO

San Francisco attorney Melvin M. Belli officially asked yesterday that his hearing for unethical conduct be changed from Dallas to the Chicago headquarters of the American Bar Association.

"There are a number of things I would like to say

... at this so-called trial," said Belli. "I would like to remain alive to say them."

The American Bar Association set the hearing of charges against Belli for June 15 in the Sheraton Hotel in Dallas. The charges stem from statements Belli made about the quality of justice in

Dallas after the trial of Jack Ruby.

In a letter to O. B. McEwan, chairman of the Bar's Grievance Committee, Belli also told the committee he would be in court on June 15 and suggested that the hearing be held in late July or late August.
