Dallas, May 28 (AP)- Jack Ruby, convicted slayer of President Kennedy's accused assassin, went berserk in his ~~D~~^a Dallas County jail cell today and was subdued by a jailer, Sheriff Bill Decker said.

The sheriff said Ruby, 53, broke his eye glasses, grabbed a cuspidor and threw it at a light bulb, breaking the light fixture.

Decker said the incident began about 4:45 a.m. today and that Ruby was "raising the devil."

Ruby faces death in the electric chair after conviction in a Dallas court for the slaying ~~fix~~ before nationwide television viewers of Lee Harvey Oswald who was charged with the killing of Kennedy.

Decker said a jailer reached the former night club operator and subdued him immediately after he smashed his glasses and the light fixture.

It was the second incident in which Ruby has become unruly in the county jail cell.

The first incident was a few weeks ago when Ruby butted his head against the cell wall and superficially injured himself.

Routine medical tests were given Ruby today. The physician who supervised the tests said he noticed scratches on the condemned man's face. It was not known if this was a result of the incident earlier in the day.

Defense attorneys have requested a sanity hearing and psychiatric examinations for Ruby.
