Dallas, Tex., June 12 (AP)- A Dallas psychiatrist hired to treat condemned killer Jack Ruby in his county jail cell resigned yesterday but offered to continue treatment as a non-paid court consultant.

Dr. William R. Beavers, a member of the faculty of Southwestern Medical School here, said he would continue to confer with county health officer J.M. Pickard concerning burther mental treatment for Ruby. Ruby is under death sentence for slaying Lee Harvey Oswald, accused presidential assassin.

Dr. Beavers said he felt he was no longer needed as a ~~private~~ consultant. He said he had spent more than 11 hours with Ruby, found him mentally ill and then made recommendations to Dr. Pickard.
