THE SOURCE SAID RUBY MENTIONED SHOOTING OSWALD DURING A CONVERSATION WITH HIS SISTER, EVA GRANT, ONE OR TWO DAYS BEFORE THE NOV. 24 SLAYING IN THE BASEMENT OF CITY HALL.

"JACK MENTIONED SHOOTING OSWALD TO MRS. GRANT AND SHE TRIED TO TALK HIM OUT OF IT. THEY HAD A BIG ARGUMENT ABOUT IT," SAID THE SOURCE, WHO DECLINED TO BE IDENTIFIED.

MRS. GRANT, HOWEVER, TOLD THE TIMES HERALD THAT SUCH A CONVERSATION NEVER TOOK PLACE.

"HE (RUBY) NEVER SAID A THING LIKE THAT," SHE DECLARED.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE CONVERSATION WAS REPORTEDLY RELATED BY
RUBY TO CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN DURING HIS VISIT TO RUBY'S CELL
LAST MONTH, THE SOURCE SAID.
