Dallas, Tex., July 16 (AP) - Dallas County probate court Judge W.F. Bartlett, Jr., has set August 6 as a tentative hearing date on an application asking appointment of a guardian for doomed killer Jack Ruby.

Ruby's brother, Sam Ruby of Dallas, describing the convicted slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald asxet "of unsound mind and wholly incompetent," requested Dallas atterney C.A. Droby be appointed legal guardian.

The application was filed today for Sam Ruby by his brother's chief defense attorney, Claybon Fowler. The application said there is reason to believe that outside persons will try to exploit the condemned man for their own personal gains.
