Fort Worth, Tex., Sept. 3 (AP)- Karen Lynn Bennett, the young stripper who made headlines during the Jack Ruby murder trial, has resumed her nightclub career.

Known as Little Lynn, she is the featured attraction at a Jacksboro highway night spot northwest of Fort Worth. The five-night run ends Monday.

She had been in seclusion since the Ruby trial in March.

Newspaper advertisements gave her star billing and declared:

"You read about her on front pages -- Life, Look, Post, Time magazines and saw her on TV -- Now! See her in person."

Little Lynn first appeared at the Ruby trial courtroom with a pistol in her purse. The gun later was found to be ineffective as a weapon.

A jail break occurred during her second visit. She was pregnant at the time.

She previously worked at Ruby's Carousel Club in Dallas. Ruby had wired her money only moments before he gunned down Lee Harvey Oswald, accused presidential assassin.

She said her Skyliner appearance will be her swan song as an "exotic dancer." She did not reveal her plans beyond that point.

Reportedly 19 during the trial, she says now she is 22.
