Dallas, Oct. 21 (AP)- Dist. Judge Joe B. Brown saidlast night he will takeno action on a request that he oust defense lawyers Clayton Fowler and Joe Tonahill from the Jack Ruby murder case.

Mrs. Eva Grant, a sister of the concemned slayer, made the request in a letter. She asked Brown to rule that the only "attorneys of record" in her brother's case are Sol Dann of Detmoit, <sup>C</sup>harles Bellows of <sup>C</sup>hicago and Phil <sup>B</sup>urleson of Dallas.

This, in effect, would remove Fowler and Tonahill from the case. <sup>M</sup>rs. Grant said shemade the request on behalf of the Ruby family "because of the condition of Jack's mental processes."

Brown ordered her letter forwarded to the Texas mf Court of Oriminal Appeals along with other papers in the case. The jurist said it is not his job todecide who should represent Ruby in appealing the death sentence for killing accused presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.

Fowler, presently chief of the defense staff, says he was hired by Ruby personaly and the family cannot fire him.

Mrs. Grant said she acted under power of attorney from her brother granted Feb. 4.

Fowler and Tonahill clashed with Dann over strategy when the Detroit lawyer came here to seek a guardianship hearing for Ruby.
