

Saturday Evening Post Is Sued for Libel by Belli

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 17 (AP) — Melvin Belli, the lawyer, filed a \$2 million suit against The Saturday Evening Post Tuesday, charging libel for allegedly derogatory remarks concerning his conduct of the Jack Ruby trial in Dallas. The suit was filed in Superior Court here.

It named as defendants the Curtis Publishing Company, which publishes The Post; the Golden Gate Magazine Company, Edward Linn, Richard Warren Lewis and others identified only as "First Doe through and including 10th Doe."

Mr. Belli represented Ruby, the former Dallas night club operator who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President John F. Kennedy. Ruby was convicted and sentenced to death. The case is on appeal.
