

OSWALD'S WIDOW ASKED  
THAT RUBY BE SPARED

Marina Oswald disclosed in testimony released yesterday that she had written a letter to attorneys prosecuting Jack Ruby asking that her husband's killer be spared the death penalty.

"It is simply that it is pity to - I feel sorry for another human life," she told the Warren Commission last February. "Because this will not return - bring back to life (President) Kennedy or the others who were killed."

Mrs. Oswald said at the time that she had not mailed the letter.
