RUBY PLUS YEAR (300)

DALLAS, TEX., NOV. 24 (AP)-JACK RUBY SAT IN A COUNTY JAIL CELL TODAY, DABBED AT A LUNCH OF GRILLED LIVER WITH RICE AND ONION GRAVY, AND LET HIS THOUGHTS DRIFT EACH ONE YEAR.

IT WAS ABOUT THE SAME TIME NO NOV. 24, 1963, THAT RUDY LUNGED FORWARD IN THE CITY HALL BASEMENT AND FIRED A DULLET INTO LEE HARVEY OSWALD WHILE MILLIONS OF AMERICANS WATCHED ON THEIR TELEVISION SCREENS.

THAT ACT MADE RUBY'S WARE A MOUSEMOLD WORD. IT ALSO EROUGHT

SHERIFF BILL DECKER SAID THE FIRST AMJIVERSARY OF THE MURDER OF OSWALDAN A 24-YEAR-OLD MARKIST ACCUSED OF ASSASSINATING PRESIDENT KENNEY HERE, WAS "JUST AMOTHER DAY" FOR RUDY.

THE FOLLOWED THE SAME ROUTINE HE FOLLOWS ON OTHER DAYS. AND HE ATE THE SAME FOOD AS OTHER PRISONERS, " THE SHEREFF SAID.

DECKER SAID RUBY, WHO MANAGED A DOWNTOWN STRIPTEASE CLUB BEFORE SHOOTING OSUALD, SPENDS MUCH OF HIS TIME PLAYING CARDS AND DOMINOS WITH GUARDS ASSIGNED TO HIS CELL.

DECKER KEEPS RULY APART FROM OTHER PRISONERS TO MAKE CERTAIN THEY DO NOT HARM HIM.

DECKER REFUSES TO LET REPORTERS SEE RUBY. AS A RESULT, THEY MUST DEPEND ON HEARSAY ACCOUNTS WHEN WRITING ABOUT TRUEY'S PHYSICAL AND MENTAL CONDITION.

DEFENSE ATTORNEYS SAY RUBY HAS "GONE STEADELY DOWN HILL" SINCE HIS ARREST.

DRIVEN BEYOND THE DETAKING POINT, THE LAWYERS SAY, RUBY ATTEMPTED TO KILL HIMSELF.

DIST. ATTY. HENRY WADE SCOPPS AT THE SUICIDE CLAIM AND SAYS HE IS CONVINCED RUBY MERELY "PUT ON AN ACT."

DECKER, WHO SAYS HE BARRED REPORTERS "FOR SECURITY REASONS,"
DECLINES TO EXPRESS AN OPINIOR ABOUT RUBY'S MENTAL CONDITION.
"I'LL WAIT UNTIL THEY PUT ME ON THE WITNESS STAND," THE SHERIFF SAYS.

ALTHOUGH THE SLAYER IS PALE FROM HIS LONG STAY BENIND JAIL BARS, DECKER SAYS HE EATS WELL AND "APPEARS TO WEIGH ABOUT THE SAME AS HE DID WHEN HE CAME IN."

PROSECUTORS SAID RUBY SQUEEZED THE TRIGGER OF HIS COLT CODRA IN THE BELIEF THAT THE MURDER OF OSNALD WOULD MAKE HIM KNOWN THROUGHOUT THE LAND.

IF THIS WAS RUBY'S GOAL, HE SUCCEEDED. BUT HIS FAME MAY STILL COST HIM'HIS LIFE.
