SEEKS TO DISMISS TONAHILL AS AN ATTORNEY IN THE APPEAL. I HAVE NO INDICATION IF AND WHEN THE COURT WILL ACT."

HAYES SAID THERE WERE FIVE OR SIX SIGNATURES ON THE MOTION BUT HE DID NOT KNOW WHOSE THEY WERE.

RUBY'S SISTER, MRS. EVA GRANT, SAID RECENTLY SHE WOULD ASK THE COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS TO BAR TONAHILL FROM ARGUING IN RUBY'S DEFENSE.

TONAHILL, WHO HAS THE LONGEST TENURE ON THE CONTINUALLY CHANGING RUBY LEGAL STAFF, HAS REFUSED TO WITHDRAW. HE SAID HE WAS REPRESENTING RUBY, NOT THE FAMILY.
