Judge Holland was named to preside in the Ruby case when Judge Joe B. Brown of Dallas recently stepped out of the case.

Here for the state bar convention, Judge Holland was asked if TV cameras might be allowed inside the courtroom when the jury was not present.

The judge said he had reached no decision on this matter.

The jurist said he would bar TV cameras during the jury's presence because of the U.S. Supreme Court's reversal of a conviction of Billie Sol Estes.
