DETROIT, OCT. 7 (AP)-EARL RUBY THURSDAY WITHDREW A PETITION ASKING THAT HE BE NAMED GUARDIAN OF HIS BROTHER JACK RUBY'S ESTATE IN WAYNE COUNTY (DETROIT).

EARL RUBY SAID ALSO MORE THAN \$55,000 HAD BEEN SPENT IN HIS BROTHER'S DEFENSE SINCE THE SHOOTING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ALLEGED ASSASSIN, IN A DALLAS, TEXAS, JAIL NOV. 24, 1963.

EARL, OWNER OF A CLEANING ESTABLISHMENT HERE, SAID THE PETITION WAS WITHDRAWN TEMPORARILY "UNTIL SOME THINGS ARE CLARIFIED IN DALLAS."

THE PETITION WAS DISMISSED BY PROBATE JUDGE THOMAS S. MURPHY.

EARL RUBY SAID HIS BROTHER'S POSSESSIONS IN MICHIGAN AMOUNTED TO ABOUT \$1,100 IN PERSONAL EFFECTS.
