

Ruby Brother Drops Plea

DETROIT (AP) — The brother of Jack Ruby has withdrawn a petition that he be named guardian of Ruby's estate in Wayne County (Detroit).

The brother, Earl Ruby, said more than \$55,000 has been spent in defending Ruby since the Nov. 24, 1963, Dallas jail shooting of Lee Harvey Oswald, two days after Oswald killed President John F. Kennedy.

Earl wanted the petition withdrawn "until some things are clarified in Dallas."

Probate Judge Thomas S. Murphy dismissed Earl Ruby's petition. Ruby said his brother's Michigan possessions amount to about \$1,100 in personal effects.
