

**Jury Finds Ruby Sane;
Decides in 15 Minutes**

DALLAS, June 13 (UPI)—A jury found Jack Ruby, confessed slayer of President Kennedy's assassin, sane today. Ruby made a dramatic personal appeal to the jury to find him of sound mind.

The sanity trial had been ordered the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals to see whether Ruby had the mental capacity to dismiss Joe H. Tonahill, one of the original lawyers in the case.

The defense lawyers, including Mr. Tonahill, were present in court, but took no part in the proceedings, beyond objecting, and presented no witnesses.

After hearing Ruby's plea and a short argument from assistant district attorney Bill Alexander, the jury took less than 15 minutes to reach its decision. Ruby faces death for the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald, who killed President Kennedy on Nov. 22, 1963.
