DALLAS, TEX., DEC. 20 (AP)-JACK RUBY WAS TROUBLED BY A SICK STOMACH AS HE TOOK MORE DRUGS IN A FIGHT AGAINST CANCER.

RUBY, 55, KILLLED LEE HARVEY OSWALD TWO DAYS AFTER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY WAS ASSASSINATED NOV. 22, 1963. THE WARREN COMMISSION NAMED OSWALD AS THE ASSASSIN.

THE FORMER NIGHTCLUB OPERATOR IS BEING TREATED IN PARKLAND HOSPITAL, WHERE KENNEDY AND OSWALD DIED.

HE WAS "TROUBLED WITH VOMITING," HOSPITAL SPOKESMEN SAID YESTERDAY. THEY SAID HE REMAINED IN SERIOUS CONDITION AND HIS PHYSICAL CONDITION WAS ESSENTIALLY UNCHANGED.

RUBY WAS ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL DEC. 9. HE FACES A NEW TRIAL FOR SLAYING OSWALD IF HE RECOVERS.

NIGHT LEAD RUBY (140)

DALLAS, TEX., DEC. 20 (AP)-JACK RUBY, A VICTIM OF CANCER, REMAINED COMFORTABLE TODAY AS HE TOOK MORE DRUGS IN PARKLAND HOSPITAL, THE HOSPITAL REPORTED.

THE 55-YEAR-OLD FORMER NIGHT CLUB OPERATOR KILLED LEE HARVEY OSWALD TWO DAYS AFTER PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY WAS ASSASSINATED HERE NOV. 22, 1963. THE WARREN COMMISSION IDENTIFIED OSWALD AS THE ASSASSIN.

AT PARKLAND, WHERE KENNEDY AND OSWALD DIED, DOCTORS SAID RUBY'S CONDITION WAS UNCHANGED. SMALL AMOUNTS OF FLUID STILL DRAINED FROM HIS RIGHT CHEST THROUGH CHEST TUBES.

A 5 P.M. BULLETIN ON THE PRISONER'S CONDITION, ISSUED BY PARKLAND HOSPITAL THROUGH THE OFFICE OF SHERIFF BILL DECKER, SAID:

"MEDICINES WERE ADMINISTERED INTO THE CHEST TUBES TODAY TO ENHANCE CONTROL OF THE DRAINAGE OF THE CHEST SPACE. MR. RUBY'S CONDITION REMAINS OTHERWISE UNCHANGED AND HE IS RESTING WELL."

THE HOSPITAL SAID RUBY HAS UNDERGONE DRUG TREATMENT WELL.
HE WAS ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL DEC. 9.

A NEW TRIAL AWAITS RUBY FOR SLAYING OSWALD IF HE RECOVERS.
HE RECEIVED A DEATH SENTENCE IN HIS FIRST TRIAL, WHICH AN APPELLATE COURT THREW OUT.
