

## Lie-Detector Test May Be Given to Ruby

Austin, Tex.

Attorney General Waggoner Carr asked the Texas Department of Public Safety yesterday to arrange a lie detector test for Jack Ruby if Ruby's doctors approve.

Ruby lies stricken with cancer in Parkland Hospital in Dallas. He received his second blood transfusion in 24 hours yesterday as doctors said his condition had improved over Wednesday.

He has told his lawyers that he wants to take a second lie detector test to prove that he was not part of any conspiracy when he killed Lee Harvey Oswald on November 24, 1963.
