2 Polygraph Experts Urge Lie Detector Test for Ruby

DALLAS, Dec. 25 (UPI)—
Two polygraph experts think Jack Ruby should be given a lie detector test "in the interest of history."

Several Texas authorities contend it is too late for a valid test because of the widespread cancer in Ruby, the slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, who killed President Kennedy. Chris Gugas, Los Angeles polygraph expert, said yesterday that some agency other than the Texas Department of Public Safety should give the test. He and Cleve Baxter of New York, sent a telegram to the Texas Attorney General Waggoner Carr, asking that they be allowed to give the test.
