
The 'Scandal Mongers' and Ruby's Death

Jack Ruby's death probably will add fuel to the criticism by "scandal mongers" of the Warren Commission's findings, a senior counsel to commission said here yesterday.

But Joseph A. Ball, Long Beach attorney, said he does not think the death of Ruby should have any effect on the basic finding that Lee Harvey Oswald alone killed President Kennedy.

"He (Ruby) always denied the fact of a conspiracy," Ball said at a news conference preceding a Town Hall luncheon address. "He said he was emotionally affected by the murder of the President of the United States."
