
Handwritten Will Of Jack Ruby Filed for Probate

Dallas

A will written by the late Jack Ruby in pen and ink in 1950 was filed for probate yesterday by a Dallas law firm that represented his business at that time.

Two sisters and nephew were listed as beneficiaries by Ruby, whose estate was estimated at \$25,000 by attorney Marvin Levin.

Levin said the Ruby will was found on file after news reports from Detroit that the accused slayer had died without leaving a will. There were no witnesses to the will, but under Texas law a will is valid if it is completely in the person's handwriting.
