

Judge Acts on Ruby Will

DALLAS, March 23 (AP) — Probate Judge Ted Robertson Thursday appointed James K. Allen, a former assistant district attorney, as temporary administrator of Jack Ruby's estate. Jules Mayer, a lawyer who says he wrote a will for Ruby at Ruby's direction Aug. 24, 1950, had asked to be named administrator.

Ruby, who died Jan. 3, was the slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President Kennedy.
