\$45,637 in Taxes Is Sought From Ruby Estate by U.S.

DALLAS, April 6 (AP)—The Federal Government has filed a claim of \$45,637.43 for back taxes against the estate of Jack Ruby, who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, the slayer of President Kennedy.

Ruby died of cancer last January.

The claim, Internal Revenue Service officials said Thursday, is for taxes dating back to 1956 over five separate tax periods. The service first filed an income tax claim against Ruby for \$14,106.37 in 1956. A second claim specifies \$16,204.90 in unpaid taxes plus fees and fines of \$6,497.99. There were some lesser claims.

There has been no official indication of the size of Ruby's estate, but it is not expected to be large.
