DALLAS, TEX. (AP)—A FORMER ROOMMATE OF JACK RUBY'S SAYS HE HAS SOLD ONE OF RUBY'S SUITS TO THE WAX MUSEUM AT THE STATE FAIRGROUNDS FOR \$300.

GEORGE SENATOR SAID THE TRANSACTION WAS COMPLETED LAST WEEK. HE WAS RUBY'S ROOMMATE AT THE TIME RUBY KILLED LEE HARVEY OSWALD ON NOV. 24, 1963, TWO DAYS AFTER PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS SLAIN IN DALLAS. THE WARREN COMMISSION NAMED OSWALD AS THE ASSASSIN.

SENATOR SAID RUBY GAVE HIM THE SUIT THREE WEEKS BEFORE RUBY SHOT OSWALD. HE SAID HE HAD TO SELL THE SUIT BECAUSE HE HAS HAD TROUBLE GETTING A JOB.

ALTHOUGH SENATOR SAID MONDAY HE HAD ALREADY CASHED THE \$300 CHECK, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MUSEUM WOULD NOT CONFIRM THAT THE SUIT HAD BEEN BOUGHT.

**Ruby Suit Sold to Museum**

DALLAS, June 20 (AP)—A former roommate of Jack Ruby says he has sold one of Ruby's suits to the wax museum at the state fairgrounds for \$300. George Senator said the transaction was completed last week. He was Ruby's roommate Nov. 24, 1963, when Ruby killed Lee Harvey Oswald, the assassin of President Kennedy.
