CHICAGO — Attorney Mel Belli, once fired as Jack Ruby's defense attorney, now has been retained by the Ruby family to file a \$1 million malpractice suit against a Chicago hospital. The Ruby family, unhappy with Belli's defense of the man who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, alleged assassinator of President John F. Kennedy,
