The Warren Commission was formed by the FBI and the FBI never took place. An extensive search of the records of the Chicago Police Department did not reflect any reference to John Martin, Jack Ruby or Jack Rubystein or to the name of Leon Cook (p. 17). (Warren Commission document Volume XXIX, Page 345). The State Attorney's office in Illinois seized the books and confiscated the charter in 1939 while Mr. Ruby was its secretary-treasurer explaining that it was not a union but rather "a fraud, a front for organized crime."

The Warren Commission reported that "several long-time members of the union reported that it had a good reputation when Ruby was affiliated with it." (Warren Commission Report, Page 783).

As time passes, it becomes clearer that no material question was resolved by the Warren Commission and that an investigation by the Congress into all of the facts surrounding John F. Kennedy's death might be far more topical than some suspect.
