U.S. Won't Accuse Seamen

MANILA, April 15 (AP)—A United States Coast Guard spokesman said today that no formal charges would be filed against the two merchant seamen who forced the American munitions ship Columbia Eagle to sail to Cambodia March 13. The ship was released by Cambodia last week and sailed to the United States naval base in Subic Bay.
