CIA 'Problem'*

LISBON, Oct. 11 (AP) — Brig. Otelo Carvalho, chief of military security and a key leftist figure in the ruling Armed Forces Movement, said in an interview published today that Portuguese intelligence officers are "taking the measures they deem necessary" to solve the "grave problem" presented by CIA activities in his country.

"The Americans have a morbid terror of communism and as you know have a series of specific organs to fight against it. The CIA, which uses the most incredible methods — and you only have to look at the example of Chile — is probably the most dangerous, but it is not the only one: NATO is another," he said.
