

N.Y. Bar Urges Curb on CIA Role

NEW YORK April 6 (UPI)— The New York City Bar Association today warned that domestic CIA activities have a serious potential for infringement of first amendment rights. In a 46-page report, the lawyers' group called for legislation that would more clearly define the spy agency's role and give Congress a stronger command of its purse strings.
