F.B.I. Academy Is Accused Of Barring Dallas Police

DALLAS, June 6 (UPI)— The Federal Bureau of Investi-gation has refused to admit any Dallas policemen to its national training academy since the as-sassination of President Ken-nedy, The Dallas Morning News said Sunday.

nedy, The Dallas Morning News said Sunday. The News said it was the "popular belief in the police de-partment" that "F.B.I. Director J. Edgar Hoover himself or-dered Dallas omitted." "This suspicion is based sole-ly on events that took place following the assassination, in-cluding the sparring between Dallas police and the F.B.I." The News said. "The F.B.I. initially reacted to the feud by pulling out its instructors from the Dallas Police Academy a year ago," the newspaper said.
