Richard Sprague, a management consultant and photograph researcher, says he has spent a year and a half gathering and studying photos taken around the time of the assassination; has listed 510 such photos, counting any movie sequence as one; has seen 480 himself; believes FBI has seen only about 50 and Warren Commission 26. Believes JFK was "caught in a crossfire by shots from three and possibly more persons," none of them in the sixth floor window of TSED.
