FBI Aide Is Worried About U.S.

Thomas E. Bishop, assistant director of the FBI, sadi yesterday the United States was "well on the way to national suicide."

"Wherever we turn today, we find lawlessness, the advocates of civil disobedience, the acts of riot and rebellion, the anarchist theory that laws considered wrong need not be obeyed, the use of force or mob action instead of constitutional methods to rectify grievances," he said in a speech to a service club.

He denounced the "hippie, the dropout, the amoral advocate of unfettered individual freedom, the anti-society new leftist, the citizen who wants only the good life with no responsibilities, who knows only how to criticize, to tear down, but has nothing positive to offer."

"In our midst are the communists, the undeviating followers of Moscow, the trained revolutionaries who are prodding every antimovement," he said.
