
Group Reports Attempt to Rob L.I. Offices of F.B.I.

A group calling itself the People's Bureau of Investigation reported yesterday an unsuc-cessful attempt to break into and steal documents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation's office in Garden City,

An anonymous woman caller telephoned The New York Times to report the attempt,



taken in that theft and have been released periodically to the press, giving the public glimpses into the shadowy world of undercover investigations and intelligence gathering. The documents have also fanned a growing national controversy over the F.B.I.'s role in domestic surveillance and J. Edgar Hoover's direction of the office.

The F.B.I. spokesman refused to comment on the possibility of a link between the Media and the Garden City actions. A visitor to the Garden City office reported yesterday that the three holes had been fresh-
