FBI Working Overtime

Without specifically asking for any more agents, FBI director J. Edgar Hoover pointedly told Congress yesterday that his agency paid enough overtime last fiscal year to hire 2066 more men and still save money.

"Heavy demands are placed upon the FBI to provide coverag of the activities of the hard-core New Left terrorists and black and

white extremists," Hoover told the Senate Appropriations Committee. "Urban guerrilla warfare espoused by some of these groups poses a very serious threat to law enforcement and to the entire nation."

He made the statement in testimony which was released after he appeared in private before the Senate Appropriations Committee on the FBI's proposed \$336.3 million budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1.
