

F.B.I. Man Reassigned

PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 13 (AP)—Thomas F. Lewis, who was in charge of the Federal Bureau of Investigation office in Media, Pa., when it was raided by antiwar activists last year, has been reassigned to the F.B.I. office here, officials said. Mr. Lewis was suspended for a month after the Media incident and then was transferred to the F.B.I.'s Atlanta office.
