**F.B.I. Chief Pledges Fight  
On the Nation's Extremists**

L. Patrick Gray 3d, acting director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, said Thursday that law enforcement officials were determined to root out what he called the nation's extremists bent on social change through violence.

"There are elements in our society that preach an incessant litany of hatred — and slander — against law enforcement officers," he told a luncheon of the New York City Rotary's Club, according to The Associated Press.

"There are extremists— both of the right and left — who are bent on fomenting violent confrontations with the law."
