Suspension of FBI **Agent Confirmed**

Attorney General Richard C. Kleindienst confirmed yesterday that a veteran FBI agent, Robert N. Fitzpatrick, has been suspended from duty pending sufferment of an internal ing outcome of an internal investigation.

Kleindienst, in the city for a meeting of the Federal Bar Association of which he is president, refused to discuss the reason for the sus-

pension.
"I don't comment on investigations or those who are being investigated," he

told a news conference.

Washington columnist Jack Anderson reported Tuesday that a high-ranking agent of the FBI in Detroit was under investigation. Anderson said the investigation concerned allegations that an agent accepted bribes from mobsters.

Fitpatrick, a 22-year FBI veteran and former head of the Detroit bureau's organied crime section, has been on paid administrative leave for several weeks pending outcome of the investigation.
