Mathematician in Spy Case
Denies Guilt in U.S. Court
BALTIMORE, Sept. 26 (UPI)
—Sahag K. Dedeyan, a mathematician accused of cooperating with an alleged Soviet spy, pleaded not guilty today to a charge of failing to report the photographicing of a classified document.

United States District Court Judge Alexander Harvey 2d tentatively scheduled Mr. Dedeyan's trial for Oct. 29 and permitted him to remain free on \$20,000 bail. Mr. Dedeyan, all years old, answered all quesitions at the arraignment.
