Protest Against F.B.I. Here Chinese-Americans Stage

Two dozen Chinese-Americans, some of them shouting "I am furious, yellow," picketed the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigations here yesterday to protest statements they said had been made by F.B.I. director J. Edgar Hoover.

The demonstrators, at 201 East 69th Street demanded a retraction of the remarks.

They said Mr. Hoover told a House subcommittee last April that "we are being confronted with a growing amount of work in being alert for Chinese-Americans and others in this country who would assist Red China."

"There are over 300,000 Chinese in the United States, some of whom could be susceptible to recruitment either through ethnic ties or hostage situations because of relatives in Communist China," the demonstrators quoted Mr. Hoover as having testified.
