Dallas, May 16 (AP) - There have been 50 murders in Dallas since Jan. 1 and Presidnet John McKee of the Dallas Crime Commission forecasts a record tot by year's end.

If murders contunue at the current rate, he told directors of the commission, the figure will reach 150 for all of 1964.

The number of murder victims for the first four month of this year is 13 greater than the 37 recorded for the same period in 1963.

McKee reported major crimes in Dallas have increased 17 percent this year, c pared to a 6 per cent rate of increase nationally.
