## DALLAS SOUGHT AUTOPSY BEFORE BODY'S REMOVAL

BODY'S REMOVAL Two Dallas officials tried to prevent removal of Pres-i d e n t Kennedy's body from the city until an au-topsy was performed, the Warren Commission report has disclosed. The officials, who are not named in the report, told m e m b e r s of the White House staff at Parkland Hospital that the body could not be removed pending the autopsy. At that point, the body already had been placed in a coffin and was ready for removal. Despite the protests, the coffin was wheeled out of the hospital, placed in an ambulance and transported to the airport shortly after 2 p.m.
