"After President Kennedy was shot, we now know there were twelve men, not ten, who were arrested and taken to Sheriff Bill Decker's office where they were held until Lee Oswald was captured. So far as we know, onlyseven of the men were taken out of two railroad boxcars shortly after the shots were fired. One boxcar was near the School Book Depository Building, the other near the Post Office Annex south of Commerce St."
