

JFK Childrens' Guard Held in Shot at Cabbie

NEW YORK, June 11 (UPI) — A member of the Secret Service team that guards the children of the late President Kennedy was arrested today

after he allegedly fired a shot at a cab driver.

Police identified the man as John J. List, 28, of Bogota, N.J. A Secret Service spokesman in Washington said List is assigned to the detail guarding John F. Kennedy Jr. and Caroline Kennedy.

Their mother, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, forfeited her Secret Service guard when she remarried, the spokesman said.

According to sketchy police reports, List was cut off by the cab driver north of the Times Square area at 2:53 a.m. He then fired one shot over the the top of the cab, of reckless endangerment.

List was booked on a charge of reckless endangerment.

The Washington spokesman said no disciplinary action had been taken against List.
