

State Dept. Responds To Criticism

WASHINGTON — (AP) — State Department officials, responding to criticism in the Warren Report for failure to post "lookout cards" on Harvey Lee Oswald's passport file, said they now have a special watch list system on defectors.

In their testimony to the Commission, Department officials indicated clerical slip-ups had caused the shortcomings in the Oswald file.

Officials said the Department is studying the Warren Report "very carefully and will as a matter of course review departmental procedures in light of the Commission's findings."
