Dismissal of Otepka's Silft

Upheld by Appeals Court

RICHMOND, July 31 (AP)—
A Federal appeals court upheld today a lower court's dismissal of a libel suit filed against aletter published in The New York Times by Otto F. Otepka, a former State Department security official.

The United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit affirmed the dismissal in a one-paragraph ruling in which it said it could find no error in the action taken last November

by 1974 United States District Court in Baltimore.

Mr. Otepka brought an action against The Times in February, 1971, on the basis of a letter published in The New York Times Magazine on March 15, 1970.

Mr. Otepka, employed by the State Department from 1953 to 1969, called the letter a malicious attack on him and said that it had been published with reckless disregard for the truth.
