BALTIMORE AP - Arthur H. Bremer's plea for dismissal of
federal charges against him stemming from the May 15 shooting of
Gov. George C. Wallace of Alabama will be heard in U.S. District
Court July 7, the federal judge said Monday.
Chief Judge Edward S. Northrop set the hearing on that pretrial
motion and five others filed by Benjamin Lipsitz, the
court-appointed attorney for Bremer.
Lipsitz is to renew his arguments on the state level Wednesday
at a hearing in Prince Georges County Circuit Court. 'he attorney
contends the state and federal charges overlap and that only
one jurisdiction should be assigned the trial.
A total of 46 witnesses have been subpoenaed by Arthur A.
Marshall Jr., Prince Georges County state's attorney, for
the July 12 trial in the state court.
Although the witness list includes Wallace, Marshall
said Monday he does not expect him to appear and can present
his case without the governor's testimony.
