
Insanity Plea In Wallace Shooting

Upper Marlboro, Md.

Arthur H. Bremer pleaded innocent by reason of insanity yesterday to state charges in connection with the shooting of Alabama Governor George C. Wallace and three other persons.

The plea was entered by Benjamin Lipsitz, Baltimore attorney for Bremer. The 21-year-old Milwaukee man was not in the courtroom.

Bremer is also under federal indictment in connection with the shooting of Wallace at a May 15 campaign rally at a Laurel, Md. shopping center. He has pleaded innocent to those charges. Insanity may be used as a defense but not a plea in Federal proceedings.

The state trial is scheduled to open here July 12 and the federal trial five days later in Baltimore.
