Bremen Pleads Not Guilty
To Charges by Maryland

UPPER MARLBORO, Md., June 28 (AP)—Arthur H. Bremer pleaded not guilty today by reason of insanity to a state charges in connection with the shooting of Gov. George C. Wallace of Alabama and three other persons.

The plea was entered by Benjamin Lipsitz, Baltimore attorney for Mr. Bremer. The 21-year-old Milwaukee man was not in the courtroom.

An earlier plea of not guilty his arraignment May 30 by the was entered for Mr. Bremer at court when Mr. Lipsitz said he was not sure if he would be able to represent Mr. Bremer in the state case.

Mr. Bremer is also under Federal indictment in connection with the shooting of Mr. Wallace at a May 15 campaign rally at a Laurel, Md., shopping center.
