

## Bremer Denied New Trial

UPPER MARLBORO (Md.) — (UPI) — A Maryland judge has turned down a request for a new trial for Arthur Bremer on the conviction of attempting to kill Alabama Gov. George Wallace.

Benjamin Lipsitz, Bremer's defense attorney, told judge Ralph Powers yesterday that the prosecution offered inadequate evidence and the jury had been prejudiced by news coverage of

the shooting at a nearby shopping center May 15.

Powers rejected both contentions.

Bremer, who was sentenced to 63 years in prison, has been held in the Maryland penitentiary in Baltimore since his conviction Aug. 4.

Lipsitz said he is trying to raise \$2000 so that he may enter additional appeals. The money is needed to pay for a transcript of the trial.
