Bremer Says A Pass Was Made at Him

Baltimore, Md.

Arthur Bremer, serving a 53-year prison term here for last May's shooting of Alabama Governor George Wallace, has accused a fellow Maryland Penitentiary inmate of making homosexual advances, a warden said yesterday.

The incident reportedly occurred last Friday night as Bremer, who has been at the prison since August 4, was about to leave his cell to watch television.

A man approached the cell and allegedly made verbal homosexual overtures to Bremer, said Gerald H. McClelland, a penitentiary warden.

Bremer's cell door had been opened for him to watch television and there was a "small scuffle" between the 22-year-old inmate and the other man, McClelland said.

A three-man disciplinary panel is scheduled to conduct a hearing on the report either today or tomorrow, McClelland said.
