

**Bremer Charge Dismissed**

BALTIMORE, Oct. 13 (UPI) —A hearing panel at the Maryland State Penitentiary Friday dismissed today charges by Arthur H. Bremer that another prisoner had made homosexual advances and threatened his life unless he submitted. The panel found no evidence to substantiate the charges and ordered a 90-day suspension of movie-viewing privileges and exercise in the yard for the convicted assailant of Gov. George C. Wallace. The prison panel found Bremer to be the "aggressor" in the incident that resulted in a scuffle after the alleged advance. There was no reprimand for the other prisoner.
